4. Places striking point of the tool on the lower corner of the window.		
<b>5. Ensures that all occupants and other responders are aware of the intention to break class. (“breaking glass”, “breaking glass”, “breaking glass”)</b>		
<b>6. Breaks glass in a proper method.</b>		
<b>7. Uses a tool to clear the remaining glass. (Does not use hand to clear glass.)</b>		
8. Glass removal avoids causing further hazard or injury.

Demonstrate removing laminated auto glass with an assistant.

1. Identifies and retrieves the appropriate tool to complete the assigned task.		
<b>2. Assess the area for fire/explosion and other hazards.</b>		
<b>3. Ensures that all occupants are covered and/or protected from glass and debris.</b>		
4. Positions themselves and their assistant on opposite sides of the vehicle glass.		
<b>5. Ensures that all occupants and other responders are aware of the intention to break class. (“breaking glass”, “breaking glass”, “breaking glass”)</b>		
<b>6. Make vertical cuts on each side of the glass in a proper method.</b>		
<b>7. Cut along the roof line to connect the vertical cuts.</b>		
<b>8. Cut along the bottom to connect the vertical cuts. Candidate or assistant shall hold the glass while the other cuts to prevent possible harm to occupant from falling debris.</b>		
9. Glass is removed and placed in a location that is out of the way of scene operations.		
10. Glass removal avoids causing further hazard or injury.		
<b>YELLOW BOLD indicate a CRITICAL step and any unsafe act constitutes a failure of skill.</b>

1. Identifies and retrieves the appropriate tools to complete the task.		
<b>2. Identifies vehicle construction, condition, integrity, and support locations on vehicle.</b>		
<b>3. Assesses area for fire, explosion, and other hazards.</b>		
4. Assesses area and determines enough surface location to provide solid base for deployment of vehicle stabilization equipment and to support vehicle weight.		
<b>5. Retrieves, utilizes, and deploys cribbing as primary stabilization of a motor vehicle to limit horizontal movement of the vehicle.</b>		
<b>6. Identifies the need to provide additional stabilization and retrieves appropriate shoring tools/equipment to complete the task.</b>		
7. Deploys shoring to provide additional stabilization of a motor vehicle.		
<b>8. Re-assesses motor vehicle to ensure proper stabilization.</b>		
<b>9. Maintains situational awareness at all time.</b>
