1. Determines hazards.		
2. Select an appropriate PPE ensemble for the mission-specific assignment.		
3. Perform a visual inspection of PPE for damage or defects.		
4. Don structural PPE and respiratory protection.		
5. Pull hood up completely so that facepiece straps and skin are not exposed.		
6. Breathe through respirator and ensure it is functioning properly. Don helmet.		
7. Perform pre-entry checks as per AHJ's SOPs.		
8. Perform work assignment. After assignment has been performed, proceed to decontamination line.		
9. Undergo decontamination as per AHJ's SOPs.		
10. Doff ensemble according to AHJ's SOPs, avoiding contact with outer ensemble or surfaces that may be contaminated.		
11. Conduct a post-entry inspection of PPE for damage or defects according to AHJ's SOPs and document findings.		
12. Clean and disinfect PPE according to local SOPs and manufacturer's instruction.		
13. Return to proper storage as per manufacturer's instructions.

1. Determines hazards.		
2. Select an appropriate PPE ensemble for the mission-specific assignment.		
3. Ensure that all responders involved in decontamination operations are wearing appropriate PPE for performing emergency decontamination operations.		
4. Ensure emergency decontamination is set up in a safe area.		
5. Wash immediately any contaminated clothing or exposed body parts with flooding quantities of water.		
6. Remove mannequin PPE/clothing rapidly, minimizing the spread of contamination.		
7. Perform a quick cycle of head-to-toe rinse, wash, and rinse.		
8. Transfer the victim to treatment personnel for assessment, first aid, and medical treatment.		
9. Ensure that ambulance and hospital personnel are told about the contaminant involved.		
10. Complete required reports and supporting documentation.

5. Identify and locate the emergency remote control valve and/or emergency shutoff device.		
6. Operate the remote-control valve and/or emergency shutoff device.		
7. If necessary, decontaminate tools and advance to decontamination line for decontamination.		
8. Notify the Incident Commander of the completed objective.		
9. Complete required reports and supporting documentation.
